More frequent and severe asthma attacks

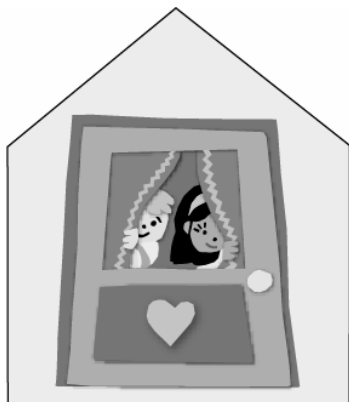
Breathing secondhand smoke is linked to:
